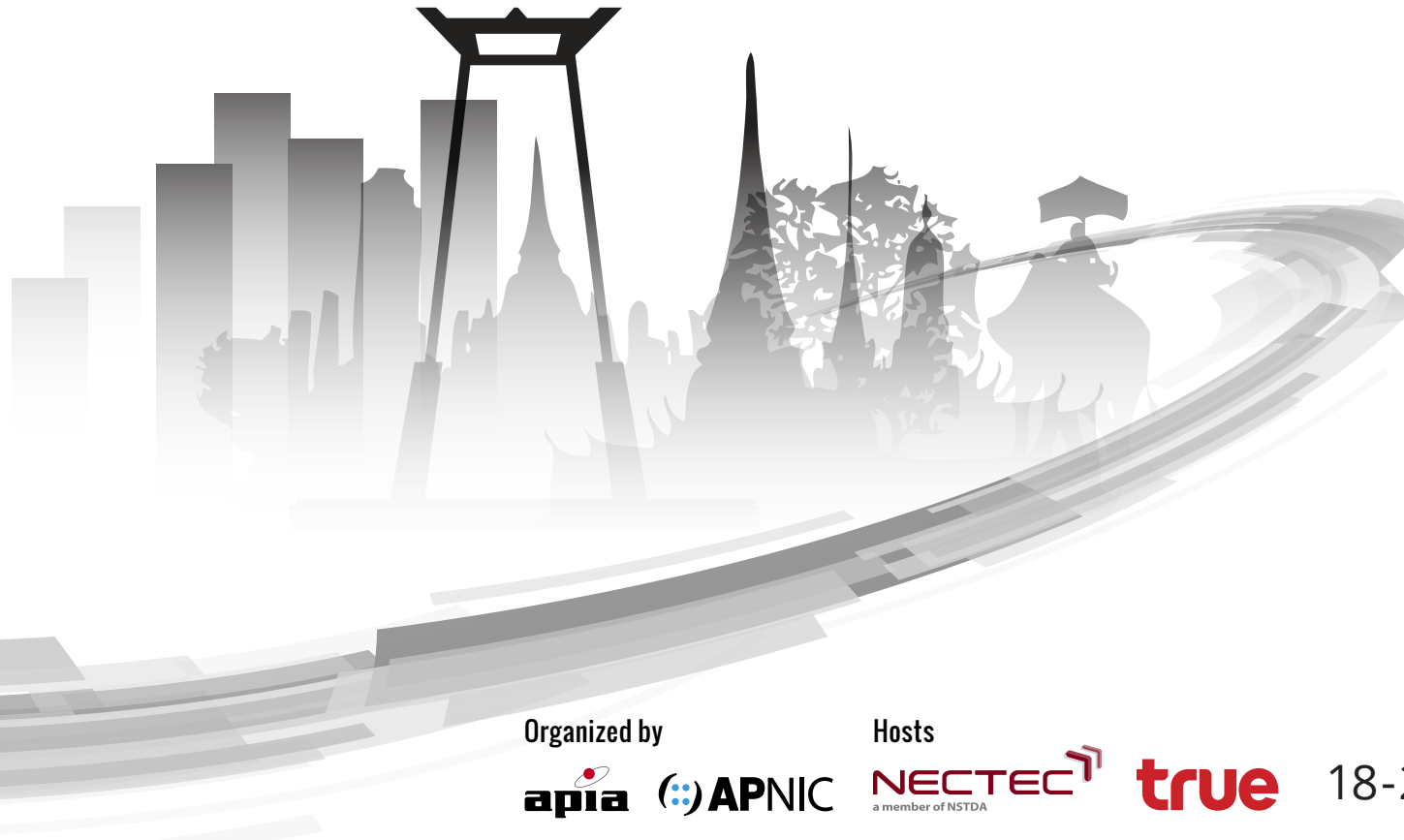

What to expect?

The APRICOT 2014 summit is a two-week program that consists of a workshop week and a conference week. The workshop week features intensive and hands-on sessions to provide the region's operators with the fundamental knowledge required to build and manage their networks. Sessions typically include:

- Network management
- Network security
- IPv4/IPv6 BGP routing

The Conference week consists of a variety of sessions to help the community build and manage the Internet. These typically include:

- Tutorials, such as Internet Routing, Network Management, and ISP/IXP Network design. International guests and APNIC Trainers provide hands-on training at these sessions to help the community build robust and scalable infrastructure.

- IPv6 sessions, which discuss issues related to IPv6 deployment, and feature real-world deployment content.
- The Asia Pacific Operators Forum (APOPS), which is a forum for discussing operational issues relevant to the region.
- Lightning talks, which are a series of quick presentations on topics of interest.
- Birds of a Feather (BoF) meetings, which are informal gatherings where participants can exchange information and discuss new ideas.
- The Policy SIG, where anyone can submit a proposal and have their say in how Internet resources are managed.
- The AMM, which is a forum for APNIC Members to learn about APNIC's operations and activities.
- Networking events to make new contacts and build new relationships.
